Charlotte FC & Ally Partner in Commitment to Youth Soccer in Charlotte Impact plan includes funding to youth soccer organizations, play-at-home soccer kits for youth and donation of youth soccer goals

The kit will also include a book, *Planet Zeee and the Money Tree* in English and Spanish. The book, developed by Ally, helps families and teachers educate children on the fundamentals of budgeting, smart saving and giving back to the community.

The final phase of the impact program will commence in the fall when Charlotte FC and Ally will provide cobranded youth soccer goals to the organizations that are participating in Charlotte FC afterschool programming.
