Foundation donates \$25,000 to support a veteran's life-changing road to recovery

CAMDEN, N.J. – NOVEMBER 7, 2023 – The [American Water Charitable Foundation](#), a 501(c)(3) organization established by American Water (NYSE: AWK), the largest regulated water and wastewater utility company in the U.S., and American Water's Military Services Group, announced today that the Foundation awarded a \$25,000 State Strategic Impact grant to K9s For Warriors, the nation's largest provider of trained Service Dogs for veterans with invisible wounds of war.
