

## West Virginia American Water Announces 9th Annual Protect Our Watersheds Art Contest

CHARLESTON, W.Va. (Mar. 1, 2024) – West Virginia American Water announced today entries are being accepted for its ninth annual Protect Our Watersheds Art Contest. Students in third, fourth and fifth grades located in areas served by West Virginia American Water are eligible to enter.
