- A leaky faucet can waste nearly 3,200 gallons of water per year.
- Toilets
- These silent water wasters can usually be fixed by adjusting or replacing the flapper valve.
- Washing machine
- If you see water on the floor under your washing machine, contact a repair person. You may need to replace your drain hose.
- Tub spouts and shower heads
- Leaks here can waste hundreds of gallons per year. If you notice one, be sure to address it as soon as you can.
- Boiler system
- If the sound of running water is continuous and does not stop and start periodically, there may be a leak. Contact a professional to check it out and perform repairs.
