American Water Provides Wills for First Responders, Pro Bono Will Preparation Service with Inaugural Event in Norristown

Beginning in May 2024, American Water and Morgan Lewis legal professionals conducted phone interviews with participating first responders and started document preparation on their behalf. The process culminated with in-person meetings among American Water, Morgan Lewis and participating first responders yesterday in Norristown, PA, where the documents were reviewed, signed and notarized.

"Thank you to everyone involved - it's a great service you're providing for first responders," said Bryan Boyer, an officer with the Norristown Police Department. "Everyone was very clear and helpful along the process."

Through the pro bono program, American Water provides several basic estate planning service options, including wills, financial power of attorney and

health care power of attorney/living will. Referrals are provided for more complex estate requirements.

The company hopes to continue expanding Wills for First Responders throughout additional communities in <u>states it serves</u>.
