Boil Water Advisory Lifted for 18 Customers in Upper Mount Bethel

Scranton, Pa. (Feb. 22, 2026) – Pennsylvania American Water announced this morning that the boil water advisory for customers in Upper Mount Bethel has been lifted. Customers were notified on Feb. 20, 2026, of the loss of positive water pressure, resulting in the issuance of the boil water advisory. We are pleased to report that the issue has been resolved.

This notice applies to 18 customer connections in Pennsylvania American Water’s Bangor system in Upper Mount Bethel from 120 Persimmon Lane to 336 Persimmon Lane (13 homes) and 1256 Fox Gap Road to 1408 Fox Gap Road (5 homes).

Samples were collected on Feb. 20, 2026, and Feb. 21, 2026, with acceptable test results received on Feb. 22, 2026. The Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection has authorized lifting the advisory.
