Update: Banner leader provides news about hospitalizations, vaccines during COVID-19 surge

Marjorie Bessel, MD, chief medical officer, provides comments in press conference available for download

PHOENIX (Jan. 27, 2021) – Today, Marjorie Bessel, MD, chief clinical officer at Banner Health addressed COVID-19 topics during a virtual press conference. Topics included:

- Arizona continues to have highest number of COVID-19 infections per capita
