
Banner Primary Clinic on Cortaro offers urology services

TUCSON, Ariz. (November 9, 2020) – <u>Sunchin Kim, MD</u>, has joined the Banner – University Medicine urology team. Returning to Tucson, Dr. Kim also has been appointed assistant professor at the University of Arizona College of Medicine – Tucson. Dr. Kim specializes in trauma and reconstructive urology, general urology and robotic surgery.

In addition, <u>Cara Whittingham</u>, <u>NP</u>, a nurse practitioner, will provide general urology services at the Cortaro clinic. Whittingham specializes in general urology such as kidney stones, hematuria, urinary tract infections, urinary incontinence,

prostate issues, erectile dysfunction and elevated PSA, a protein made by cells in the prostate gland that can suggest the possibility of prostate cancer.

They will be seeing patients at the <u>Banner – University Medicine Primary Care Clinic</u>, 8020 N. Cortaro Rd. #150, Tucson, 85743.

Dr. Kim received his medical degree from Wayne State University School of Medicine, in Detroit, MI and most recently finished a fellowship in genitourinary (genital and urinary organ) reconstruction at the University of California, San Diego.

Whittingham has been with <u>Banner - University Medical Center North</u> for two years and is expanding services to the Cortaro location.

Urology is the branch of medicine that focuses on the urinary tract system and male reproductive organs.

The Banner urology team sees patients with kidney stones, overactive bladders and incontinence, pelvic floor disorders, urinary tract infections, sexual dysfunction, prostate-related issues such as benign prostatic hyperplasia (prostate gland enlargement), urologic cancer and treating children with pediatric urology issues.

Banner offers minimally invasive <u>robotic surgery</u> for <u>urological issues</u> with specially trained surgeons who can make dime-sized incisions resulting in less pain and a faster recovery time. Examples include:

- Robotic surgery for prostate cancer
- Removal of kidney tumors, called a partial nephrectomy
- Removal of ureter blockages
- Removal of all or parts of the bladder, called a cystectomy
