Blue Cross earned this NCQA accreditation after undertaking a rigorous 8-month process. As the industry gold standard for validating health care quality, NCQA's Health Equity Accreditation evaluates how well an organization complies with standards in the following six areas:

- · Organizational readiness
- Race/ethnicity, language, gender identity and sexual orientation
- Access and availability of language services
- Practitioner network cultural responsiveness
- Culturally and linguistically appropriate services programs
- · Reducing health care disparities

Blue Cross is a recognized national leader in addressing inequities in health care. Highlights include:

- We were the <u>first health plan</u> in Massachusetts and among the nation's first to introduce a<u>pay-for-equity financial</u> <u>payment model</u> with a goal of eliminating inequities in health care.
- We became the first health plan to collect data on inequities in health care and recently <u>published</u> our fifth annual health equity report.
- In 2022, we <u>funded</u> \$25 million in Institute for Healthcare Improvement grants to support physician practices and hospitals in our value-based network in their efforts to eliminate inequities in care and to share learnings across institutions.
