- Promoted primary care by growing our network and offering reimbursement increases of up to 30% to approximately 1,000 small, independent primary care providers.

- Contributed \$12.3 million in financial, volunteer and in-kind support to more than 360 not-for-profits.
- Recognized as one of the 50 most community-minded companies in the U.S., according to Points of Light, earning the top
 spot in the national health care sector.
- Eighty-five percent of Blue Cross employees participated in company volunteer programs, contributing over 21,700 hours of service to support the health of Massachusetts communities.
- Reduced carbon footprint by 6.1% in 2024, equivalent to growing 6,217 tree seedlings over 10 years.
