

## **Andria Lewis Honored as 'Woman of the Year' for Achievements and Leadership**

Lewis believes in strong corporate training and ongoing employee communications. She treats both employees and guests alike -- with great respect. Like Lewis, the employees have a strong commitment to customer service, which paves the way for the hotel to thrive.
