Members may choose airline miles from 32 participating partners instead of points and earn 500 miles toward free flights with participating airlines. Members may also earn 300 Gold Passport points when renting from Avis or Sixt Rent-a-Car (Europe only). A Hyatt stay is not required. When staying at Hyatt's partner hotel properties, AmeriSuites, *Summerfield Suites* and Hawthorn Suites, members will receive three Hyatt Gold Passport points per dollar spent on every eligible suite rate or 300 miles with one of the following airline partners: Alaska Airlines, American Airlines, Continental Airlines®, Delta Air Lines, Northwest Airlines®, Southwest Airlines® (0.5 credits), United® or US Airways®. Members may redeem Hyatt Gold Passport points for free night awards at Hyatt Hotels & Resorts worldwide, AmeriSuites, *Summerfield Suites* and Hawthorn Suites. Members may also redeem points for an upgrade to a Regency /Grand Club room or a suite at Hyatt.
