- Replacement of all guestroom thermostats with low voltage digital thermostats
- Purchased new fleet of shuttle buses. The new vans are compact and run more efficiently.
- Introduction of saline mineral pool system improves water quality and removes the need for hazardous chemicals. Some benefits are elimination of eye irritation, chlorine odor. Outcome is smooth, sparkling, clean pool water and truly pleasant guest experience.
