

New opening marks the first Miraval resort outside the United States, ushering in a new era of transformative wellbeing on The Red Sea

Chicago (June 9, 2026) – [Miraval Resorts & Spas](#) has announced the opening of [Miraval The Red Sea](#) on Shura Island, marking the brand's first destination outside the United States and a defining milestone in its global evolution.

Set between desert and water on Saudi Arabia's west coast and surrounded by mangrove forests, the adults-only retreat introduces the Miraval signature blend of mindfulness and intentional wellness to the region. Rooted in the brand's 30-year philosophy of mindful living, the Miraval brand's guiding principle of empowering guests to 'live a life in balance' is thoughtfully expressed through elements of local heritage, creating an experience that feels both distinctly like the Miraval brand and authentically connected to place.

Architecture and interiors by Foster + Partners and Rockwell Group have created a restorative retreat of 180 guestrooms, suites and villas woven into the island's natural landscape of lagoons and mangroves using natural materials, desert tones and coral-inspired forms to achieve a calm environment.

Positioned within one of the world's most ambitious regenerative tourism destinations, Miraval The Red Sea offers guests a rare opportunity for profound stillness and wellbeing in an extraordinary setting where desert landscapes meet untouched marine ecosystems. With its adults-only approach and immersive wellness philosophy, the resort introduces a new expression of luxury travel focused on intentional living, restoration, and meaningful connection to self and destination.

The Red Sea is a pioneering destination on Saudi Arabia's west coast, inviting guests to experience a place of extraordinary natural beauty across more than 28,000 km² and an archipelago of 90+ pristine islands framed by desert and mountains. Open since 2023, The Red Sea welcomes guests to a growing collection of world-class resorts operated by world-renowned hotel brands and Red Sea Global. Shura Island, the heart of the destination, will begin welcoming guests in 2025, debuting 11 exceptional resorts alongside Shura Links golf course, a marina, retail, and dining experiences. The island is set to be fully live in 2026. Signature experiences also include high-adrenaline water and land sports to cultural and nature-based adventures, delivered by destination activity brands WAMA (over-water), Galaxea (underwater), and Akun (inland).

Red Sea International Airport (RSI) offers a seamless arrival experience, with its design inspired by the desert, oasis, and sea. Within three hours' flying time for 250 million people and eight hours for 85% of the world, RSI currently connects via regular flights from Riyadh, Jeddah, and Dubai, with additional regional and international routes launching soon.

Developed by Red Sea Global (RSG), a multi-project developer advancing responsible, regenerative tourism while actively strengthening its environment, culture, and community, The Red Sea will comprise of 50 resorts, 8,000+ hotel keys, and 1,000+ residential properties, complemented by luxury marinas, golf courses, and leisure facilities by 2030. We limited our development to accommodate no more than 1 million visitors a year at The Red Sea and 500,000 at AMAALA to protect the delicate ecosystems, and the destination is powered by 100% renewable energy, targeting a 30% net conservation benefit by 2040.
