

Park City Mountain Now Open for the 2018-19 Season

- Park City Mountain opened today for the 2018-19 season.
- Both the Park City Mountain Village and Canyons Village are now open.

PARK CITY, Utah – Nov. 21, 2018 – Park City Mountain, the largest ski resort in the United States, is now open for the 2018-19 season. Lifts started spinning at 9 a.m. at both the Park City Mountain Village and the Canyons Village as eager skiers and snowboarders lined up to make the first tracks of the season. The celebration will continue tomorrow as the resort celebrates [Thanksgiving Day](#) on the slopes.

The resort opened this morning with runs off of Payday, First Time and 3 Kings lifts at the Park City Mountain Village and Red Pine Gondola, High Meadow, Saddleback, the Cabriolet and Frostwood Gondola at Canyons Village. Park City Mountain is debuting significant enhancements across the resort this season including a new beginner learning area and express lift at High Meadow Park, an expansive transformation of Mid-Mountain Lodge, a 200-seat expansion of Cloud Dine and additional snowmaking. High Meadow Park is now open for guests to enjoy. Mid-Mountain Lodge and Cloud Dine are scheduled to open in December as terrain continues to expand.
