50th Anniversary of ABBA's Eurovision Song Contest Victory - April 6, 1974

50 years ago, ABBA, the iconic Swedish pop group, achieved a historic victory at the Eurovision Song Contest (ESC) in Brighton on April 6th, 1974. They won with their legendary song "Waterloo," which catapulted them to international fame. ABBA's triumph at ESC marked a crucial moment in their career, setting their status as one of the most successful musical acts in the world.

60th Anniversary of the IKEA Hotel in Älmhult

But much remains from 1964 - the copper roof has been converted into the reception and the limestone floor has been preserved. As has the open fireplace in the restaurant.
