

## Success when Malmö Welcomes the World Premiere of “Joyride the Musical” – A Tribute to Roxette

**Malmö Opera in Sweden is hosting the world premiere of *Joyride the Musical*, a new feel-good production paying tribute to the timeless music of Swedish pop legends Roxette.**

The musical takes audiences on a joyful, humorous journey filled with powerful ballads and stunning performances. Since its debut on September 6, the show has received rave reviews from both audiences and critics.
